

- ➤ Alunorte: 25 years in operation, the world's largest alumina refinery outside China, accounts for 60% of alumina production in Brazil
- ➤ Albras: 35 years in operation, accounts for 50% of primary aluminium production in Brazil, supplies 10% of primary aluminium needs of Japan through NAAC(*)

Alunorte (alumina) - 60% of domestic production

Albras (primary aluminium) - 50% of domestic production

Aluminium supply chain is considered as the essential activity (*)
