Lack of confidence hits highest number of industrial sectors since June 2020

In January 2025, industry confidence fell in 24 of the 29 industrial sectors considered, in all regions of Brazil and in all company sizes (small, medium, and large).

With the worsening of confidence, industries in the North, Central-West regions and seven industrial sectors shifted from confidence to lack of confidence between December 2024 and January 2025. Thus, in January 2025, lack of confidence affects 23 industrial sectors, the highest number since June 2020.



ICEI by Industry Sectors

In December, industry confidence fell in 24 of the 29 industrial sectors considered and increased in the remaining five sectors. With the drop in confidence, seven industry sectors shifted from confidence to lack of confidence between December 2024 and January 2025. Only one sector made the opposite transition, from lack of confidence to confidence: miscellaneous products.

Thus, between December 2024 and January 2025, the number of confident sectors fell from 11 to 5 and the number of sectors with lack of confidence grew from 17 to 23, the highest number of sectors without confidence since June 2020.

ICEI by company size

The ICEI fell in all company sizes, especially in small companies (-2.8 points), followed by medium (-1.6 point) and large (-1.4 point).

With the drop, large industrial companies stopped registering confidence and now show neutrality. Meanwhile, small and medium-sized companies registered a deepening of the lack of confidence.

In January 2025, industrial business confidence fell in all regions of Brazil. The biggest drop occurred among the industries in the North (-3.3 points), followed by those in the Central-West (-2.9 points), South (-2.1 points), Southeast (-1.7 point), and Northeast (-0.5 point).

The ICEI of the North and Central-West regions fell below the dividing line of 50 points, marking a transition from confidence to lack of confidence between December 2024 and January 2025. Thus, in January 2025, with the exception of the industries in the Northeast region of Brazil, the industries in the other regions register a lack of confidence.
