



Industrial Confidence Rises in December

In December 2023, the Business Confidence Index increased by 0.6 points, from 50.4 to 51 points. This result follows two months of decline and one month of stability in industrial business confidence. The industry remains confident in December, as the confidence index remains above the 50-point dividing line, which separates confidence from lack of confidence.



*The index ranges from 0 to 100. A score above 50 points indicates entrepreneurs' confidence. The further above 50 points, the greater and more widespread is the confidence. A score below 50 points indicates a lack of confidence among entrepreneurs. The further below 50 points, the greater and more widespread is the lack of confidence.

Business Confidence Index Components

The increase in confidence in December was primarily attributed to a less negative assessment of the current conditions of both the Brazilian economy and companies.

The Current Conditions Index increased by 1.1 points to 46.8 points. The index remains below the 50-point threshold, indicating a continued deterioration in the current conditions of the Brazilian economy and companies over the past six months. The deterioration, however, is less intense and widespread than in November, according to entrepreneurs.

The Expectations Index remained relatively stable, experiencing a modest increase of 0.3 points, reaching 53.1. Standing above the 50-point dividing line, the index continues to indicate optimism for the next six months. Entrepreneurs' optimism, however, is confined to their own companies (56.5 points), while pessimism about the future of the Brazilian economy persists (46.3 points).
