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

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Industry business confidence advances again in June

The Business Confidence Index (ICEI) edged up by 3.2 points in June 2021, reaching 61.7 points. This is the second consecutive increase of the confidence index, which now accumulates an increase of eight points since April. The business index thus increases the distance in relation to the 50-point dividing line, which separates confidence from lack of confidence, indicating greater and more widespread optimism in the industry.

With the increase in confidence in June, the confidence of the industrial entrepreneur approaches the levels recorded in the second half of 2020, a period of strong recovery for the Brazilian economy.



*The index ranges from 0 to 100 points. Figures above 50 points indicate business confidence. The further above 50 points, the greater and more widespread is the confidence. Figures below 50 points indicate lack of business confidence. The further below 50 points, the greater and more widespread is the lack of confidence.

ICEI components

All components of the business confidence index increased in June 2021. It should be noted the increase in the Current Conditions Index, whose growth indicates a more positive perception of the current conditions of the Brazilian economy and of companies. The index grew 4.6 points to 54.8 points, thus moving away from the 50-point dividing line that separates a negative perception from a positive perception of current conditions.

The Expectations Index, which was already at a high level, grew 2.5 points, reaching 65.1 points, indicating even more optimism of the industry for the next six months.



*The index ranges from 0 to 100. Figures above 50 points indicate a better situation than the last six months. Figures below 50 points indicate a worse situation.



*The index ranges from 0 to 100 points. Figures above 50 points indicate optimistic expectations. Figures below 50 points indicate pessimistic expectations.
