








Drop in industrial confidence in September interrupts sequence of advances

In September 2023, the Industrial Entrepreneur Confidence Index (ICEI) fell 1.3 points, from 53.2 points to 51.9 points. The result interrupts a sequence of four months of confidence growth that had been happening since May.

Despite the drop, the industry remains confident, as the confidence index remains above the dividing line of 50 points, which separates confidence from lack of confidence.




^{*}The index ranges from 0 to 100. A score above 50 points indicates entrepreneurs' confidence. The further the score is above 50 points, the greater and more widespread the confidence is. A score below 50 points indicates entrepreneurs' lack of confidence. The further the score is below 50 points, the greater and more widespread the lack of confidence is.

Business Confidence Index Components

There was a retreat mainly from the components of the index related to the Brazilian economy.

The current conditions index remained stable at 47.3 points. By remaining below the dividing line of 50 points, the component continues to demonstrate a perception of worsening current conditions of the Brazilian economy and companies.

The expectations index fell 2.0 points to 54.2 points. By remaining above the dividing line of 50 points, the number continues to indicate industry optimism for the next six months. However, the drop indicates weaker and less widespread optimism. Expectations about the Brazilian economy deteriorated, falling from 51.5 points to 48.2 points, thus crossing the dividing line of 50 points, which indicates a transition from optimism to pessimism about the next six months of the Brazilian economy.



*The Index ranges from 0 to 100. A score above 50 indicates that conditions are better than in the last six months and a score below 50 indicate that conditions are worse.
