








Business confidence dropped in September

The Business Confidence Index (ICEI) dropped 5.2 points in September 2021, reaching 58 points. The ICEI had reached the highest level of the year in August and, with this drop,

is back to a level close to that of May. The drop interrupted a sequence of four consecutive monthly increases.

As the ICEI remains above the 50-point dividing line, it shows that entrepreneurs are still confident. The drop, however, shows that optimism has become less strong than in previous months.

Figures below 50 points indicate lack of business confidence. The further below 50 points, the greater and more widespread is the lack of confidence.


ICEI components

The Current Conditions Index dropped 5.3 points, to 52.2 points. By remaining above the 50-point dividing line, the index shows that entrepreneurs are perceiving improvements in the current conditions of their companies over recent months. However, this perception is more moderate than in previous months.

This still positive perception is restricted to the current conditions of companies, whose index remained above 50 points despite having dropped from 58.1 points to 54.6 points. The index measuring the current conditions of the Brazilian economy fell below the dividing line, from 56.2 points to 47.3 points. This shows that, according to entrepreneurs' assessment, the current conditions of the Brazilian economy are worsening.

The Expectations Index dropped from 66.0 points to 60.9 points, showing that entrepreneurs remain optimistic for the coming months, but that this optimism has become less strong and widespread.
