

Registration process

Arrival

RIO Galeão – International Airport Tom Jobim;

Taxis, vans and UBER to go from the airport to the hotel, and the hotel to de venue. The transport service must be hired by the teams. SESI is not providing this service.

VISA

For teams needing a **VISA** they can ask for a Letter of invitation to apply.

Safety

It's desirable that children under the age of 12 must always be accompanied by an adult while in the Pit area.
