Industry confidence has a widespread decline in December

In December 2024, industry confidence declined, affecting 27 out of 29 sectors, all regions of Brazil, and all company sizes (small, medium, and large).

The decline was enough for the ICEI of 16 out of 29 sectors, the Southeast and South regions, and small and medium-sized companies to shift from a state of confidence to a state of lack of confidence.



In December, industry confidence fell in 27 out of 29 industrial sectors, increased in 1 sector, and did not vary in 1 sector. With the declines, 16 industry sectors migrated from confidence to lack of confidence between November and December. Only one industry sector made the opposite transition, from lack of confidence to confidence: computer, electronic, and optical equipment.

Thus, between November and December 2024, the number of confident sectors fell from 27 to 11 and the number of sectors lacking confidence grew from 2 to 17, the highest number of pessimistic sectors since May 2023.

ICEI by company size

The ICEI fell in all industrial company sizes, especially in medium-sized companies (-3.0 points), followed by large companies (-2.6 points) and small companies (-1.9 points).

With the drop, small and medium-sized industries migrated from confidence to lack of confidence. Therefore, only large industrial companies are confident in December.

In December 2024, industry confidence fell in all regions of Brazil. The decline was more pronounced in the South (-4.0 points), Southeast (-2.5 points), and Northeast (-2.3 points) regions and more moderate in the Midwest (-1.6 points) and North (-1.2 points) regions.

The ICEI of the Southeast and South regions crossed below the 50-point dividing line, marking the transition from a state of confidence in November to a state of lack of confidence in December. Industries in the North, Northeast, and Midwest remain confident despite the decline in confidence in December.
