# Industries in the Midwest register lack of confidence in June

In June 2025, industrial confidence fell in the Midwest and Southeast regions, among large companies, and in 14 out of 29 industrial sectors. Confidence increased in the North and Northeast regions and in 15 out of 29 industrial sectors.

With the decline in confidence, large industrial companies and industrial companies in Brazil's Midwest region shifted from a state of confidence to a lack of confidence. Among industrial sectors, the beverage sector experienced the same shift.

# ICEI by Industry Sectors

In June 2025, industrial confidence increased in 15 out of 29 industrial sectors and fell in the remaining 14 sectors. As a result, two sectors transitioned from lack of confidence to confidence: perfumery, cleaning, and personal hygiene, and rubber products. On the other hand, one sector made the opposite transition, from confidence to lack of confidence: beverages.

The balance for June 2025 is seven confident industrial sectors, 21 industrial sectors with a lack of confidence, and one neutral sector.

#### ICEI by company size

In June 2025, industrial confidence remained practically stable among small and medium-sized companies, with a variation of -0.2 points for both sizes. Among large companies, however, there was a 0.5-point decline in confidence, which was enough for this group to shift from confidence to lack of confidence. Nevertheless, despite being in negative territory, the confidence index for large industrial companies remains close to the 50-point dividing line, indicating that the lack of confidence is not very strong or widespread.

Thus, in June 2025, companies of all sizes registered a lack of confidence.

In June 2025, industrial confidence fell among companies in the Midwest (-2.1 points) and Southeast (-0.5 points), remained stable among companies in the South, and increased among companies in the North (+1.7 points) and Northeast (+0.6 points).

With the June decline, industrial companies in Brazil's Midwest region shifted from confidence to lack of confidence, joining companies in the South and Southeast regions. Meanwhile, industrial companies in the North and Northeast regions remain confident.
