

FEAR OF UNEMPLOYMENT AND LIFE SATISFACTION



Fear of unemployment declines between June and September

The Fear of Unemployment Index dropped by 1.2 points between June and September, but remains above its historical average. The Life Satisfaction Index in turn grew by 1.6 points, getting closer to its historical average.

The September result breaks a sequence of two consecutive increases in fear of unemployment. The declines in the indicator in September are more pronounced within least skilled labor (i.e., those who studied up to 4th grade of elementary school) as well as among those with a monthly household income of up to one minimum wage.

Among the geographic regions, the North/Midwest region recorded the steepest decline (-5.3 points). The Northeast was the only region to show an increase in fear of unemployment (+3.7 points).

The increase in life satisfaction is higher among those with a college degree. Considering the geographic regions, the indicator recorded growth across all Brazilian regions, particularly in the South, whose index edged up by 2.6 points in September.

The indicators are better than they were in the same period a year ago. The Fear of Unemployment Index is down by 7.6 points from the figured registered in September 2018, while the Life Satisfaction Index is up by 3.1 points on the same comparison basis. On a year-over-year basis, all the survey strata experienced a decline in fear of unemployment and an increase in life satisfaction.


