# Industrial confidence improves among small companies, but remains below neutral levels

In May 2025, the Business Confidence Index (ICEI) revealed a modest improvement across the industrial sector, with small businesses leading the gains. The index for small enterprises rose from 45.6 to 47.6 points, reflecting a positive shift. However, the figure remains below the neutral 50-point threshold, indicating that small businesses continue to operate in an environment of lack of confidence.

The recovery in confidence extended beyond small businesses, with medium and large enterprises also reporting slight improvements during the same period. Regionally, industries in the Southeast, South, and Central-West registered notable increases in confidence. Furthermore, 21 out of the 29 industrial sectors analyzed reported gains, signaling a recovery in industrial sentiment.



In May 2025, industrial confidence increased in 21 of the 29 industrial sectors and declined in the remaining eight sectors. As a result, three sectors transitioned from a lack of confidence to confidence: Printing and Reproduction, Other Manufacturing, and Machinery and Equipment. Conversely, three sectors moved in the opposite direction, from confidence to a lack of confidence: Biofuel, Footwear and Parts. and Motor Vehicles.

The balance for May 2025, as in April, continues to show a lack of confidence in 23 of the 29 industrial sectors and confidence in only six sectors.

## ICEI by company size

In May 2025, industrial confidence advanced primarily among small industrial businesses (+2.0 points) and, to a lesser extent, among mediumsized (+0.4 point) and large-sized (+0.5 point) businesses.

With this increase, large industrial businesses transitioned from a lack of confidence to moderate confidence (index of 50.2 points). However, small and medium-sized industrial businesses continue to indicate a lack of confidence.

In May 2025, industrial confidence rose in the Southeast (+1.8 points), South (+1.0 point), and Central-West (+0.7 point) regions but declined in the Northeast (-0.6 point) and North (-0.3 point) regions.

Despite these changes, the overall scenario remained unchanged from April to May 2025: the ICEI indicates a lack of confidence among industries in the Southeast and South regions and confidence among industries in the North, Northeast, and Central-West regions.
